RIDE WITH YOUR MIND

Autumn Evenings

Can it really be that time of year again? The evenings are drawing in and there's a nip in the air - not that it seemed to get all that warm for very long this year! At least we've had a lot of dry weather for riding out - of course that brings its own problems with the ground being very hard and not much grass.

Well I've been thinking about how to make the dark evenings more interesting. Unless you're lucky enough to have lights and an indoor arena, riding after dark can be difficult. How about some interactive dismounted workshops on all the things that will help prepare us for the times when we can ride?

Muscles - which ones - how to use them to best effect to maintain correct alignment, and positively influence our horse's way of going.

Mental rehearsal - lots of different ways of practicing getting our good better, and better best.

Energy exercises - our horses are masters at reading each others energy and ours - how do we get good at this?

Learning - how do we learn, visual, audio, or kinaesthetic?

Goals - what are they? How do you make them achievable and at what cost?

Confidence - dealing with fear, banishing frustration

If all or any of these topics are of interest then you may like to join me for these low cost (£10 per evening 7.30-9.00) workshops in October and November. Give me a call for further details.

One thing I've noticed recently, with watching some of the opening matches of the Rugby World Cup, is that when one's allegiance is with a particular side, how easy it is to blame the referee for not being fair. Yet when watching matches where there is no allegiance the ref seems to be perfectly fair. How often do we do this with our horses? When we're not personally involved it's easy to be objective and see both sides, but when we're at the centre of the relationship it is so much harder!

Taking some time away from our horse can help us to become more objective about our own skills, or lack there of, and help us improve our mental, emotional and physical fitness for when we are with our beloved horse.

Highway Code for Horses

Dear readers, please note the following in respect of the recent letter asking what can be done about the horse poo upon our pavements.

Firstly, the pavements mentioned suggests to me a public right of way - on foot.

I quote Rule 54 of the Highway Code: You MUST NOT take a horse onto a footpath or pavement, and you should not take a horse onto a cycle track. Use a bridleway where possible. Equestrian crossings may be provided for horse riders to cross the road and you should use these where available (see Rule 27). You should dismount at level crossings where a 'horse rider dismount' sign is displayed.

'Must' means a legal and moral requirement and 'should' conveys a moral guide to avoid conflict with other Rights of Way users.

The existence of horse droppings indicates a breaking of the law whereby a selfish or otherwise ignorant person has potentially put others directly in danger or at least has made it hazardous for others to pass along the path.

All users of our Rights of Way, be it walkers, with or without dogs, cyclists, riders or vehicular traffic are all obliged to conform to the code in order to avoid conflicts arising.

Oh, and do please be nice to people who may point out the law, they too have rights as well as obligations!

Finally, there are in the Hopwas and and Packington parishes an abundance of bridleways, now I perceive, sadly under-used.

Are you keeping your horses in the wrong area?

Out there you can have extensive riding, some without going upon a road.

Be prepared for firework season and keep checking the local newspapers and shop noticeboards as to where and when there will be firework displays. If there are houses near to your horse's field or livery yard, it may be best to expect that there will be fireworks of some sort going off in the immediate area for the days before and after November 5th. It is believed Diwali falls on the 26th October this year, an occasion also marked by fireworks.

Many horses will cope perfectly well turned out in their field with companions - remember the 'fight or flight' response - not much chance of flight if trapped in a stable. A horse that is stabled and likely to become distressed could benefit from a sedative, something about which the owner should discuss in advance with their vet.
